

Level 2 Courses

Courses are essential for cultivating a deeper comprehension of topics previously learned in the Level 1 Curriculum.

Service fees for firefighter mental health presentations and workshops range from \$750 to \$900 per hour. Rates vary based on the number of presenters involved and the scope of handout materials provided.

The recommended class size is up to 30 participants; however, alternative arrangements can be discussed for groups outside this range. Additional costs for travel, including mileage and accommodation, would apply.

Level 3 Course for Leaders - Trauma-Informed Leadership Program (TIL)

This program is delivered in-person and is designed for organizational leaders and senior staff in leadership roles. It includes 8 hours of contact time, with scheduling tailored to meet the unique needs of your organization. *Program is developed by Wayfound, and developed by Dr. Megan McElheran

Cost: \$500 each, with a minimum spend of \$5000
